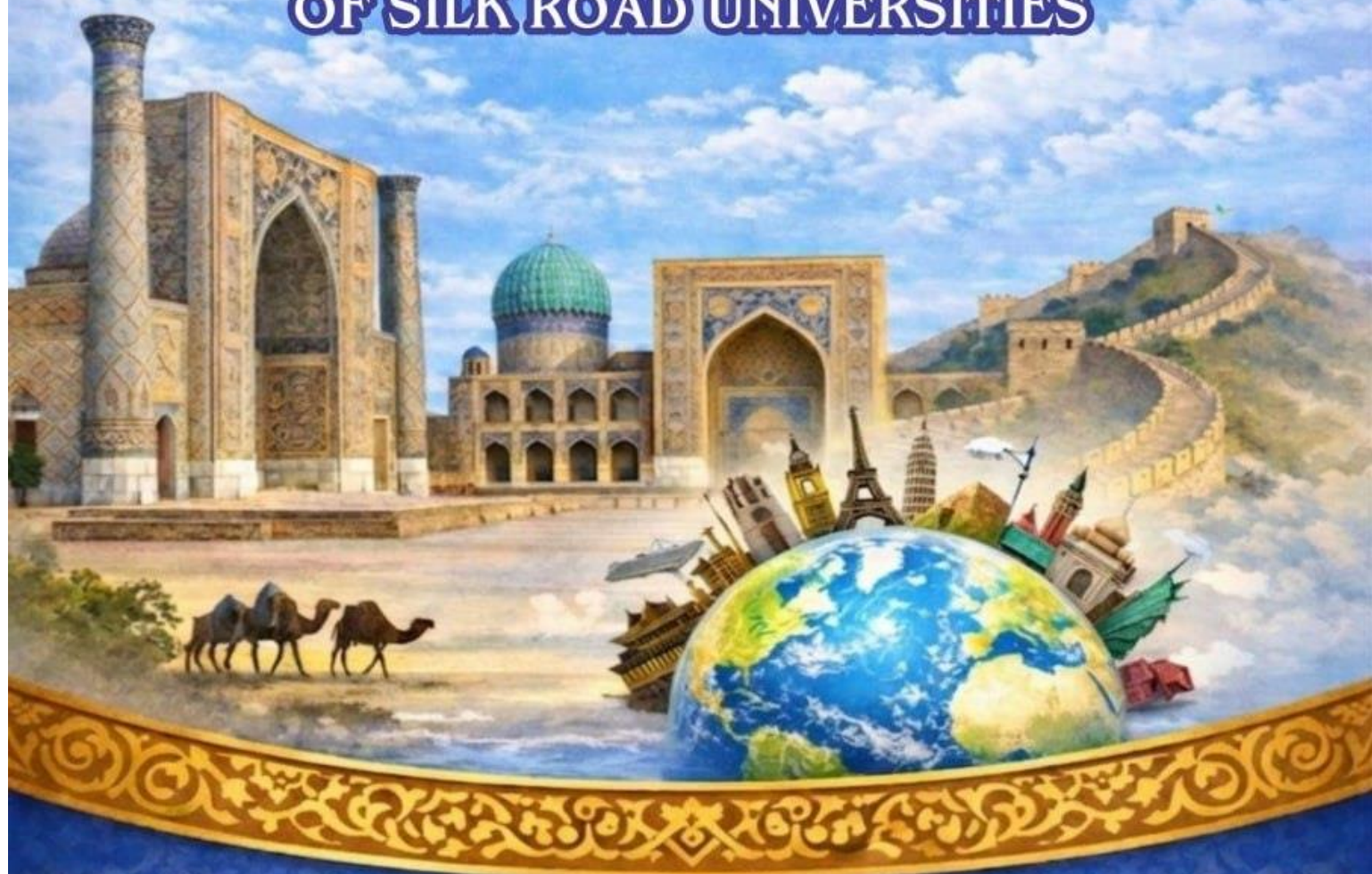

Conference languages: Uzbek, Russian, English.

The theme of the conference: “Prospects and opportunities for inclusive education in higher education: challenges and solutions”

Conference participants: It is expected that about twenty representatives of Tajikistan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Russia, Indonesia, India, as well as about fifty representatives of universities and research centers of the republic will take part in the scientific and practical conference. In addition, published scientific articles are indexed in **EUROPEAN ZENODO AND OPEN AIRE, RUSSIAN INTERNATIONAL DATABASE CYBERLENINKA** and will be indexed in the a prestigious international scientific database **Google Scholar**. Each article is assigned a unique **DOI** number.

Requirements for the preparation of scientific theses (articles):

- Abstracts submitted by conference participants must include the section and topic of the scientific article, the author’s details (last name, first name, patronymic, address, telephone number, and email), a brief abstract (minimum 30 words), and 5-6 keywords that provide relevant information in three languages.
- Abstracts should be formatted on A4 paper with a font size of 14 (Times New Roman), line spacing of 1.5, and margins as follows: 2 cm at the top and bottom, 3 cm on the left, and 1.5 cm on the right.
- The length of the abstract must be between 3 and 6 pages.

Organizational fee: To cover the costs associated with organizing the conference and publishing the proceedings, the fee for each article is 150,000 soums.

Deadline: Articles will be accepted until April 20, 2025.

Note: The article must clearly specify the conference section. Articles that do not meet the specified requirements, lack scientific and practical value, or are submitted after the deadline will not be included in the conference materials and will not be returned to the author.
